Teen swept away in flash flood near Coimbatore

Heavy rain batters Kovai and Nilgiris | Noyyal river overflows; landslips in various places

HEAVY downpour was reported across Coimbatore and Nilgiris districts from Wednesday night. Mettupalayam recorded the highest rainfall of 37.3 cm and Noyyal river overflowed. Holiday was declared for schools in Karamadai block in Coimbatore and in Nilgiris on Thursday.

Three youths were caught in a flash flood at Elerumaipallam near Kottaipirivu in Mathampalayam on Wednesday night. The incident took place when they tried to cross a bridge in a two-wheeler while returning to Kotagiri after attending a friend's wedding in Karamadai.

While two youths escaped to safety, J Pradeep Raj, 19, of Kattabettu was washed away. As many as 18 Fire and Rescue Service personnel are searching for the youth. "Despite searching for 5 km, Fire and Rescue Service personnel were unable to trace him. Along with staff from Periyanacikenpalayam fire service office, more personnel from Thudiyalur also engaged in the search," said M Karthikesan Fire officer of Periyanacikenpalayam fire

Ttraffic was suspended between Mettupalayam and Kotagiri from 6am to 3pm after landslips occurred at 15 places.

According to Mettupalayam fire officer K Balasundaram a major landslip occurred at Kunjappanai and a tree fell on the road around 5 am on Thursday. Landslips were reported in four other places and a few trees fell on the Mettupalayam - Coonoor road, Fire and rescue service personnel cleared them along with state highway workers.

Rain intensity likely to dip in state: IMD

T'Puram: The India Meteorological Department (IMD) forecast a significant reduction in rain intensity in the state from Friday. The orange alert issued in the Pathanamthitta, Idukki and Kozhikode districts is likely to be scaled down. "A trough in easterlies runs from Maldives to south Maharashtra coast in lower tropospheric levels. It is likely to cause light to moderate rainfall at most places accompanied with thunderstorms and lightning at isolated places and isolated heavy rainfall over Kerala till November 25," said a statement from IMD.

Passengers who were heading to Ooty in a SETC bus had a miraculous escape when a tree fell on the vehicle near Burliyar. A container that allegedly washed away from a construction site was found in a water source which is a branch of Noyyal river near Semmedu. A few farms that are located near the Noyyal river and cultivated raddish and banana plantations were submerged near Narasipuram.

Tourism minister K Ramachandran and Nilgiris MP A Raja inspected rain-affected areas in Queen Hills where a retaining wall was removed and Mountpleasant where landslides occurred due to heavy downpour.

Raja told reporters that 25 persons have been given accommodation at temporary shelters across the district as rainwater entered their houses and steps have been taken to provide food and water, etc.

'LEGENDS are born, not made' is a popular saying, which one can relate to chenda maestro Peruvanam Kuttan Marar, the one who led many a 'Melam' for years. His humility can be understood when people around him call the legend 'Kuttettan'. From one temple premise to another, Kuttettan travelled all over Kerala leading percussion ensembles and entertaining the public with his extraordinary skills.

As Peruvanam's 'Kuttettan' celebrates his 70th birthday on Saturday, the entire village is ready to make it a grand occasion. Leading the world's largest percussion ensemble 'Elanjithara Melam' for Paramekkavu Bhagavathi in Thrissur Pooram for a consecutive 24 years is something rare and it proclaims the kind of genius that he is.

For Peruvanam Kuttan Marar aka M Sankaranarayanan, learning the art of percussion

was a part of his lineage. Born to percussion maestro Peruvanam Appu Marar, learning and then drumming came organically and he never thought it something different. "It was part of my life and always an inevitable one. The days just went by as I continued the practice like my father and forefathers did. Mariyakutty files defamation case against daily for spreading false news

IDUKKI native Mariyakutty, lic after her social welfare pension got delayed for the past five months, filed a defa-

mation suit against CPM mouthpiece for carrying a false report against her. Though the paper had carried a corrigendum on the news report, Mariyakutty was not ready to accept

it. She said that the correction wasn't enough to cover the mental agony she had to undergo. She filed the suit on Thursday at the First Class Magistrate Court in Adimaly.

Mariyakutty's lawyer Pratheesh Prabha told mediapersons that she filed a petition against

10 persons, including the chief editor of the newspaper. "The first four accused in the case who was in the news recently are those associated with the eldest one Sali works as a gosfor seeking alms from the pub-newspaper which published pel preacher in Delhi and my the fake news while the remain-

ing ones are those who spread the false news on social media handles," Pratheesh said. After the news came

out, Mariyakutty filed an application seeking details of her land ownership, if any, with the revenue authorities in Adimaly. On November 13, the

Mannamkandam village officer certified that Mariyakutty owned no properties within his jurisdictional area.

Mariyakutty told *TNIE* that despite fabricating fake media reports, the CPM has not so far made any attempt to find a solution to her issue or tried to understand her situation.

"I have four daughters, the second daughter is married and settled in Wayanad. My third daughter is settled in Ayiramekkar nearby and my youngest daughter Princy is selling lottery tickets in Adimaly," she said.

"After my husband eloped with another woman 25 years ago, I managed to marry off my daughters doing odd jobs. However, after I underwent cataract surgery, going to work has become difficult," she said.

Mariyakutty said she had been making ends meet with the 4kg of rice she gets as monthly ration and with the support of local people who often give her food and money.

Kozhikode: Kannur Town police have registered a cheating case against former India cricketer S Sreesanth and two others, Rajeev Kumar and Venkatesh Kini, on charges of extorting ₹18 lakh from Kannur resident Sareegh Balagopalan. The case was registered following the order of the Kannur First Class Magistrate Court. As per the complainant, the accused took ₹18,70,000 from Sareegh promising a villa on a 5-cent land in Udupi, Karnataka. Rajeev and Venkatesh took money in several instalments from Sareegh from 2019. However, he didn't get any further updates from the duo. Later, he was informed that Sreesanth was starting a sports academy on the land promised to Sareegh. Sreesanth promised Sareegh that a share of his sports academy would be given to him, but Sareegh never heard anything on the offer from the trio thereafter.

Cases against news portal editor dropped **EXPRESS NEWS SERVICE**

ERNAKULAM Central police have dropped two cases registered against Shajan Skariah, the editor of Marunadan Malayali news portal, for publishing a misleading video on Kalamassery bomb blasts.

The cases were dropped after Thiruvananthapuram City cyber police and Kumarakom police registered cases against Shajan in connection with the same incident. Recently, Shajan approached the Ernakulam District and Principal Sessions Court seeking anticipatory bail in both cases. However, the pleas were closed after the police informed the court that cases against Shajan registered at Ernakulam Central police station were dropped. The case was registered after the video posted on YouTube by the portal claimed that the blasts at Kalamassery were a retaliation against Israel's attack on Palestine.
